- Take Exit 22 for Selkirk proceed to T-intersection (Rt. 144)
- Turn left onto 144 North for one mile.
- Turn hard left (almost 180 degrees) onto Beaverdam Road.
- Follow Beaverdam to second Right after crossing over the Thruway. (about 2 miles)
- Turn Right onto Trinity Place
- Follow to the cul-de-sac we are #144 grey house on right.
- Park on the center island.

From Albany via Rt. 9W

- Follow 9W south to "Becker's Corners"
- Turn left onto route 396 for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile
- Take first left onto Beaverdam Rd. for about 2 miles
- Take first left after railroad crossing. (Trinity Place)
- Follow to the cul-de-sac we are #144 grey house on right.
- Park on the center island.
