### STAND BUILDING WORKSHOP

Myron has been playing with the three tiered design that Larry presented. Myron was concerned about the portability of the stand and that if made in pieces, people would have a lot of work to do at home to put it together. So he engineered the stand you see in the photos. This stand has the two folding uprights (like Pauline's show stands) and three 8 ft. shelves that sit on the tiered uprights. The stands come apart with the uprights folding. So it can actually be put away for winter or used in your winter storage area.


We hope this modification is acceptable to everyone.
