

### PREPARING YOUR BONSAI FOR THE CLUB SHOW OCTOBER 10&11:

Show hours: Saturday 10 AM to 5 PM, Sunday Noon to 4 PM Saratoga Springs Public Library

October is not far away. Now is the time to look over your ollections of bonsai, accents and kusomono and decide which ones you will display. Make a list and give it to the show committee. This will make it a lot easier to plan the space out.

#### So what should you do now?

- 1. Give the tree a touch up trimming and wire if necessary. Remember that show wiring should show as little as possible.
- 2. Clean up the soil surface and the pot. Mossing will greatly improve it.
- 3. Decide if you would like to do a full display and search out materials to make it. Remember to ask fellow club members if you need to borrow stands, scrolls, accents. They are good at helping out.
- 4. Once you have set up all the items you are going to bring to the show, send in a list of species and spaces needed to <a href="mailto:pauline@pfmbonsai.com">pauline@pfmbonsai.com</a> please.
